SAVIA'S SOUL

SAVIA is a sanctuary to nature, biodiversity, and scientific knowledge. Developed as a natural playground, SAVIA seeks to create an experience in which its visitors can interact intimately with the flora and fauna of the tropical forest in a symbiotic manner.

SAVIA is a long live dream of Andrés Valverde and Soledad Belmar, Costa Rican entrepreneurs, loving couple parents of 3, and over 20 years of combined experience promoting sustainable tourism and the conservation of the Monteverde Tropical Forest. SAVIA was envisioned to ignite a revolution in the tropical architecture area in which humans, infrastructure, and nature coexist without negatively affecting the ecosystem.

MONTEVERDE: A SANCTUARY IN THE CLOUDS

Monteverde is the perfect example of humans and nature coexisting in harmony, respect, and wellness. Popularly known for the arrival of the Quaker community in the mid 1960s, this beautiful town is globally recognized as an example of sustainable development where private conservation, research, and outdoor recreation go hand in hand. The multicultural community, which includes locals, expats, tourists, researchers, artists, and agricultors, among others, has experienced growth and development while preserving nature and cultural identity.

Each year, over 250,000 guests are greeted in an area with more than 3,000 plant species, 500 orchid species, 120 mammal species, 130 amphibian and reptile species, more than 400 bird species, and an unaccountable amount of other species (such as fungi) many of which are unidentified.

Furthermore, due to the influence of the quaker community and the effort of all private reserves, Monteverde is, as of this day, the largest protected area in Central America. Interestingly, and contrary to a common assumption, the Government of Costa Rica does not have any public reserve in the area.

For over 50 years, Monteverde has captured the attention of biologists, conservationists and ecologist around the world, who have done extensive research in the area. Its forests have been referred to as some of the most spectacular in the Americas.

From SAVIA, our guests can enjoy a stunning view of the Pacific Ocean and feel the breeze from the Caribbean. A sanctuary where two oceans meet, clouds meet treetops, and humans meet their nature.





BIRD QUEST

Rise and shine at the pace of the forest and the birds. Monteverde is globally recognized as a bird watching destination where amateurs and experts aspire to find and admire some of the near 400 species of birds, including 30 species of Hummingbirds, that live or visit the area.

The experience is designed to learn about the ecosystem birds look for and their nature. We seek to make birdwatching accessible to all and will tailor each Immersion to the expertise, interest, and curiosity of each guest.

SAVIA

SAVIA is a spanish word that refers to the thick fluid circulating through the conductive vessels of the upper plants and whose function is to nourish the plant. This fluid contains water and mineral salts and it can be found just beneath the bark of the tree. SAVIA, thus, is a vital element of the plant and of the forest as it provides life and energy.

SAVIA showcases the dream of Andrés Valverde and Soledad Belmar, co founders and owners of this beautiful 17 acre property. Passionate environmentalists and savy tourist entrepreneurs, they envisioned a private reserve that would enable scientific research along educating and entertaining guests in an immersive intimate experience. Furthermore, igniting a revolution in the field of tropical architecture by designing and constructing a complex with both minimal impact on the ecosystem and helping its regeneration.




ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN

With the goal of maintaining sustainability and reducing negative impact, Andrés and Soledad brought to the team two highly recognized architects Cambiar a Alberto Negrini (Studio Arquitectura y Paisajismo) and José Manuel Pizarro (Linea Vertical). Both teams where requested to observe, study, and understand SAVIA's forest in order to design the master plan as well as the platforms, bridge, curiosity pods, offices, and trails that would offer a complete and accessible experiences to all the levels of the forest.

When designing the platforms and bridges, the architects took several key and innovative decisions:

- No metal objects could be used to wedge materials or puncture the tree.
- The trees cannot be strangled to hang or maintain any platform or object.
- 📅 All infrastructure in the tree must move and adapt to growth in them.
- All infrastructure should not affect in any way the growth of the tree.
- Tree elements will be removed or affected only when strictly necessary.
- Minimize the use of wood in platforms and bridges as it has a lower use life.
- Representation A study of colors of the tree was made to determine SAVIA's forest pallet.
- \(\text{\text{\$\color}}\) The architects decided to incorporate the shape of leafs to the platforms
- Reduce as much as possible metal cutting and welding jobs in the forest.
- The platforms must allow the visitor to experience all the levels of the forest.









SAVIA EXPERIENCE Designing SAVIA involved a process of experience design with the aim of having a lasting impact on our guest. Climate Change and human actions are endangering life and sustainability in the forest and every available action must be taken to reduce such impact.
